

## **RULES:**

### Set Rules

- 3 stocks
- 8 minutes
- No items
- Tournament Legal stages only
  - Hazards off
  - Starter
    - Battlefield
    - Final Destination
    - Smashville
    - Lylat Cruise
    - Pokemon Stadium 2
  - Counterpick
    - Castle Siege
    - Yoshi's Island (Brawl)
    - Yoshi's Story
    - Kalos Pokemon League
    - Unova Pokemon League
    - Town and City
  - Stage Striking
    - For the first match, players will play a best-of-1 rock-paper-scissors match. The winner of the match will be able to strike, or omit from play, one stage from being used for that match. Then the loser strikes a different stage. The players take turns until there is one stage left. They play on that stage. **FOR THE FIRST MATCH, ONLY THE STARTER STAGES ARE TO BE USED. COUNTERPICK STAGES ARE NOT ALLOWED.**
    - For every match onward, the winner of the previous match strikes *two* stages from **the whole list (counterpick and starter included)**. The loser then picks a stage from the choices left available.
    - The whole process can be neglected, however, if and only if the two players agree on a stage with no arguments throughout the set.
- All characters are allowed (please read the Mii Fighters clause in the Bracket Rules)
- The winner of a match must stay as the same character that they played previously. The loser may pick whatever character they wish.
  - For the first match, both players pick whatever character they wish.

### Bracket Rules

- Double elimination standard bracket
- Sets will be best of three, while winner's finals, loser's finals, and grand finals will be best of five.
- Mii Fighters/Control Scheme Clause
  - If you wish to use a mii fighter and/or a customized control scheme, you **MUST** create them *before* the set begins. If you do not create a mii fighter/control scheme and the set begins, you are *not* allowed to go back and create any of them.
- You must check in to your station within 5 minutes of the TO announcing your match at your station, if you fail to check in, you will **forfeit your set**.

### Other Rules/Information

- Please be respectful of the venue and the staff there. Remember that this is a religious setting, so please keep that in mind when inside the venue. If you are being rude or problematic, you are subject to being removed from the venue and your tournament run being forfeited.
- The entry fee is \$3. The prize pool is a Game Stop gift card and T Shirt
- There will be concessions for sale at the venue.
- The tournament will start at 4:00pm and is set to end at 9:00pm.
- Bring your own controller. We do *not* have enough controllers to supply to everyone, so it is highly recommended that you bring your own. If you do not bring your own, you will be at the mercy of the few controllers that are available.
